President's Message

The Schumer Shutdown

**Trumps Immigration policies are working.

On Wednesday, November 12th, Olga Cruz, a newer member of our club participated in a Zoom meeting hosted by The National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW). This is her summary:

The featured Speaker, Retired Border Patrol Agent Christopher J. Harris with 36 years of hands-on experience in Law Enforcement in NY and CA, led a powerful presentation about immigration, border security, and their impact on our everyday lives. The experts shed light on the realities at our borders during Biden's administration. Most important remarks:

- ❖ Under Biden and Obama:
 - Everything at the border was run by the cartels, people were skipping the line on the border.
 - National Border Patrol ended up doing jobs paid for by the cartels and a lot of agents were resigning.
- ❖ Two major systems were abused:
 - Asylum and parole systems. Cartels taught people what to say exactly to get asylum; for example, Chinese people would say "I am persecuted for being Christian" and Guatemalan people would say "I need to go to Oakland to get away from MS-13 gang members" etc.
- ❖ President Trump in office:
 - The border is closed and the safest it's ever been!

Agent Harris brought frontline expertise to the table and advocated practical, effective policies. The speaker concluded his expert insights and encouraged The National Federation of Republican Women to support ICE, Law Enforcement and Border Patrol.

This is our chance to dive deep into pressing national issues, gain, and build stronger connections. Far from being a border-state concern alone, those challenges touch families, communities, and our nation's future. We need to keep electing officials that will improve and solidify Trump's policies into new and solid immigration laws.

- Olga leaves us with these thoughts for discussion:

1. Jumping a fence IS a crime.
2. For any of you that still deal with those so-called "poor" illegals saviors aka "no human is illegal" in your families or friend circles I will gladly provide civil codes etc. so that you can prove it!
3. Remember, I am an immigrant myself and that topic really heats me up. When you overstay a Visa, they say "it is NOT a crime though".


