President's Message



For several years now, Democrats have openly discussed the idea of packing the United States Supreme Court. Should they gain control of both the House and Senate, many believe this could become one of their

first priorities. From there, they would be positioned to advance legislation that undermines our Constitution, relying on a newly expanded Court to uphold those policies.

To help safeguard the integrity and balance of our judicial system, Dusty Johnson and Ted Cruz have introduced a constitutional amendment during each of the last three legislative sessions stating:

“The Supreme Court of the United States shall have nine Justices.”

You may have seen the recent call to action from the National Federation of Republican Women encouraging members to contact their representatives regarding co-sponsorship of this amendment. As of this writing, Rick Scott, Ashley Moody, and Anna Paulina Luna have not yet been added as co-sponsors.

SAVE America Act. These initiatives go hand in hand in protecting election integrity and preserving our Constitutional Republic.

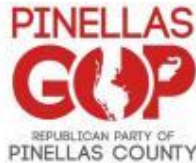

Primary Election 2026

Deadline to send vote-by-mail ballots to UOCAVA voters: July 4, 2026

Deadline to send vote-by-mail ballots to domestic voters: July 9 – 16, 2026

Deadline to register to vote or change party affiliation: July 20, 2026

Deadline to request that ballot be mailed: August 6, 2026

Early voting period (mandatory period): August 8 – 15, 2026

(Contact Supervisor of Elections for optional days of early voting)

Election Day: August 18, 2026

General Election 2026

Deadline to send vote-by-mail ballots to UOCAVA voters: September 19, 2026

Deadline to send vote-by-mail ballots to domestic voters: September 24 2026 – October 1, 2026

Deadline to register to vote: October 5, 2026

Deadline to request that ballot be mailed: October 22, 2026

Early voting period (mandatory period): October 24 – 31, 2026

(Contact Supervisor of Elections for optional days of early voting)
